**ORDER AUTHORIZING RETENTION OF WILCOX FIRM, LLC

2. The Chapter 11 Trustee is authorized to retain and employ Wilcox Firm, LLC as counsel for the Chapter 11 Trustee effective June 10, 2010.
3. The compensation of Wilcox Firm, LLC for professional services rendered shall be fixed by the Court upon application therefore and on notice as may be directed by the Court in accordance with the 11 U.S.C. §§ 330 and 331.
