**ORDER SUSTAINING OFFICIAL COMMITTEE OF UNSECURED CREDITORS'
OBJECTION TO MOTION OF CHAPTER 11 TRUSTEE
TO SELL SUBSTANTIALLY ALL OF THE DEBTOR'S PERFORMING ASSETS**

This Case came before the Court on the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors' (the Committee) Objection to the Motion of the Chapter 11 Trustee to Sell Substantially all of the Debtor's Performing Assets. (Doc. #214). On August 12, 2010, the Court held a hearing on the Committee's Objection to the Trustee's Motion and for the reasons stated on the record in open court, that shall constitute the decision of the Court, the Court finds that the Committee's Objection should be sustained.


Accordingly, it is

ORDERED:

1. The Committee's Objection to the Motion of the Chapter 11 Trustee to Sell Substantially all of the Debtor's Performing Assets is sustained.
2. The Auction and Sale Hearing for the Debtor's Performing Assets scheduled for August 19, 2010, at 1:30 p.m. is cancelled.¹
